BOARD POLICY

Definitions and Relationship of Board Policy and Operational Procedure

1. Board Policies:

Policies are defined as stated Board positions that promote general goals of the regional center. The Board Development Committee shall, at the request of the Board of Alta California Regional Center, develop policies and review these policies annually or as appropriate. The Board Development Committee shall forward draft policies and revisions to approved policies to the Consumer, Family, and Provider Advisory Committees and Board members for their review and input prior to recommendation to the Board of Directors for approval.

2. Operational Procedures:

Operational procedures are defined as staff formulated implementations of Board policies.

3. Rules and Regulations:

Alta California Regional Center operates under the regulatory requirements and guidelines of the Department of Developmental Services (and other state departments such as the Departments of Rehabilitation, Education, and Health Services).

4. Relationship:

The Board of Directors of Alta California Regional Center approves policy within the scope and direction of the Lanterman Act as well as state and federal regulation. The Alta California Regional Center staff develops and implements the operational procedures within which to carry out the policy approved by the Board of Directors.
