

## **Alta California Regional Center Continuing Education Units Guidelines**

Title 17, Section 53067 requires Service Level 2, 3, and 4 facilities fulfill requirements for continuing education in one or more of the following areas, as they relate to planning and implementation of residential services for persons with developmental disabilities:

1. Consumer services as described in the program design;
2. Promotion of consumers' rights, health, safety, and social and physical integration; and
3. The ID Team process, including development and implementation of IPPs.

Service Level 2 direct care staff shall complete a minimum of 8 hours of continuing education within each 12 month period following the assumption of the duties of direct care staff.

Service Level 3 direct care staff shall complete a minimum of 12 hours of continuing education within each 12 month period following the assumption of the duties of direct care staff.

Service Level 4 direct care staff complete a minimum of 12 hours of continuing education within each 12 month period following the assumption of the duties of direct care staff, **also**

Title 17 Section 56037 indicates that Level 4 direct care staff shall:

1. Have a minimum of six months prior experience providing direct supervision and supervision and special services, **or**
2. Within six months of beginning to provide direct supervision and special services in the facility, complete at least 12 additional hours of continuing education as specified in Title 17, Section 56037 (a)(3).
