

Under Vendored Care

A consumer was under vendored care if any of the following conditions is satisfied:

- 1) The vendor or long-term health care facility was responsible for providing services and supports to the consumer 24 hours per day. The following living situations fall under this category:
 - a. Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF)
 - b. Intermediate Care Facility (ICF)
 - c. Residential Care Facility (Care Home)
 - d. Supported Living Services (SLS)

In the above living situations, the vendor or long-term health care facility is responsible for submitting an SIR no matter where or when an incident occurs (i.e., day program, visit with family, etc.).

- 2) The vendor was actually providing services and supports at the time of the incident.
- 3) According to the consumer's IPP, the vendor was supposed to be providing services and supports at the time of the incident.
- 4) According to the consumer's IPP, the vendor was responsible for providing services and supports to the consumer 24 hours per day.
