Staff Engagement:

- Ongoing- Self Determination Q&A Sessions for Service Coordinators implemented, every Thursday.
- Ongoing ACRC Client Service Managers and Associate Directors are conducting individual staffings as additional support to Service Coordinators.
- Ongoing- SDP Tracking spreadsheet developed to capture data for participants in initial phase of the rollout. Data shared with the Department of Developmental Services, monthly.
- Participant Choice Specialist (PCS) presentation on IBCCT process at Team Unity. PCS present monthly at TU to update and connect with our team. They also hold weekly “mini-clinics” during SDP Q/A, which is followed by SDP Committee. Topics range from person centered planning tools, FMS updates, budget, spending plan, and more. PCS also attending unit meetings to answer questions.
