Alta California Regional Center (ACRC), serving individuals with developmental disabilities, and its Stakeholders has identified a need to develop multiple projects in order to better serve individuals who have high support needs. See below for a brief description of each project.

### **RFP Projects:**

<u>Crisis Support Services: Mobile Crisis Response Staffing (Project ID: ACRC-2122-6)-</u> <u>CRDP</u>. This mobile crisis support service will provide staffing to assist in stabilizing a client's intensive mental health and/or behavioral episodes through short term intervention. This service will provide support in a client's family home, private residence, or group living situations. It is anticipated that such a service could reduce incidence of hospitalization and incarceration, and could assist in helping a client maintain their community placement while mitigating need for emergency relocations.

<u>Community Crisis Home (CCH) (Project ID: ACRC-2122-8)-CPP</u>. Four (4) bed Community Crisis Home that will support clients with extensive behavioral and mental health support needs who will be transitioning from Porterville Developmental Center, Institution for Mental Disease (IMD), and other emergency facilities and/or community settings and stepping them down to a less restrictive environment. This facility will include psychiatric supports to address mental health needs as well as intensive services and treatment to address developmental needs preparing individuals for transition to a less restrictive living environment within eighteen months. Clients are expected to have severe behaviors including, but not limited to, verbal and physical aggression, property destruction, resistive to daily routines, self-injurious behaviors, and AWOL. An HDO will acquire and renovate this home for ACRC.

**Group Home for Children with Special Healthcare Needs (GHCSHN) (Project ID: ACRC-**<u>2122-16)-CRDP</u>. Five (5) bed group home for children living in the community who have "intensive support needs" and "special health care needs" as defined in WIC 4684.50. Clients targeted for this GHCSHN will be clients between the ages of 6 and 18 years, who require 24hour nursing care. Clients in this home must have medical needs that are predictable and stable as determined by a client's physician. Clients' residing in this home may require support including mobility, vision, auditory processing, nutritional support, oxygen support, tracheostomy care, management of insulin-dependent diabetes, and other medical needs which may be impacted by a developmental disability or chronic health condition. ACRC would like to set aside one of the beds for community children in need of respite services. These respite consumers must require intensive support needs and specialized health services and will decrease the likelihood that families would seek alternative, more restrictive placement for their children. An HDO will acquire and renovate this home for ACRC.
