Overview

 The Department of Developmental Services recognizes the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and of future emergencies including fires or earthquakes on service providers, staffing resources, and individuals served.

 To increase preparedness for future situations when their existing staffing resources have been exhausted.

 The goal is to connect vendors to staffing resources when shortages pose a threat to the health and safety of adults and children.

Staffing Pool Development

- Development of a staffing pool to meet the immediate need across the State will require a cooperative partnership between the Department, regional centers, service providers, staff, and The Columbus Organization.
- The support of our service provider community is needed to recruit and secure talented individuals to fulfill regional staffing needs.
 - Coordination with existing providers.
 - Providers can refer their staff (optional).
 - The contractor will not add staff to the registry or deploy staff without provider approval.
 - Columbus will not offer permanent jobs to staff in the staffing pool.

- Supported Living
