Is the COVID-19 vaccine safe?

Yes. The COVID-19 vaccines have gone through rigorous studies to ensure they are as safe as possible. Systems are in place to watch for safety issues across our country. These vaccines are being administered not just in the United States but around the world.

Why should I consider getting a COVID-19 vaccine?

- 1. COVID-19 vaccination will help keep you from getting COVID-19.** COVID-19 vaccines are highly effective at preventing COVID-19, may help keep you from getting seriously ill even if you do get COVID-19, and may also protect people around you.
- 2. COVID-19 vaccination is a safer way to help build protection.** Contracting COVID-19 can have serious, life-threatening complications, and there is no way to know how it will affect you. Plus, if you get sick, you could also spread the disease to friends, family, and others around you.
- 3. COVID-19 vaccination is an important tool to help stop the pandemic.** The combination of preventative measures, such as wearing masks and social distancing, plus getting the vaccine offer the best protection to keep you safe from COVID-19.

Are there other locations where I can get the COVID-19 vaccine?

Yes. You can make an appointment through health care networks: Dignity Health/Mercy Medical Group, Kaiser Permanente, Sutter Health, and UC Davis Health. You can also make an appointment through pharmacies: Costco Pharmacy, CVS Pharmacy, Pucci's Pharmacy, Rite Aid Pharmacy, Safeway Pharmacy, Save Mart Pharmacy, and Walgreens Pharmacy.
