### Federal Legislation

Bill Number	Title	Synopsis
HR 149 - Green	Housing Fairness Act of 2019	To authorize funds to prevent housing discrimination through the use of nationwide testing.
HR – 6042 – Guthrie	To amend the XIV of the Social Security Act to delay the reduction in Federal Medical Assistance percentage.	This bill would delay by one year (January 1, 2020) the Medicaid federal matching rate reduction that is scheduled to take effect for States that fail to require Electronic Visit Verification (EVV)
S 117 – Cardenas	Disability Integration Act of 2019	A bill to prohibit discrimination against individuals with disabilities who need long-term services and supports.

SB154 – Pan	Medi-Cal restorative dental services	This bill would authorize a provider of services for the treatment of dental caries to provide and be reimbursed for to the extent that federal participation is available.	Assembly Floor
SB163 – Portantino	Autism Health Coverage	Minor changes to existing law	Assembly Floor
SB214 – Dodd	CA Community Transitions	Requires DHCS to implement CCT, pursue and to Federal MFP program and requires DHCS to pursue federal matching funds	Held in Committee
SB398 – Durazo	Increased abuse reporting		Assembly Floor
SB412 - Stone	Repeal RC Fees	Would repeal the Cost participation fees	Died in Assembly Appropriations
