## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

**What resources can I get from a food bank during a Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) event?** All partner food banks offer non-perishable food that can support a family of four for a week.

**Are there income restrictions?** Some food banks offer food replacement to low-income customers only, while others do not have income restrictions. Please check with your local food bank.

**When can I visit the food bank?** This program offers food replacement for the duration of a PSPS event and for three days after power is restored.
