This handout will help you understand the important role of an Independent Facilitator (IF) in the Self-Determination Program (SDP). It provides a simple, step-by-step guide to how an IF can help you enroll, transition, and thrive in SDP.

WHAT DOES AN INDEPENDENT **FACILITATOR DO?** 

An Independent Facilitator (IF) is someone you hire to help you through the SDP process. They don't work for the Regional Center or service providers—they work for you. Here are some ways an IF can help:

- Person-Centered Planning (PCP): The IF helps you create a plan that reflects your dreams, goals, and challenges. They help figure out what supports you need to live your best life.
- Support Decision-Making: The IF helps you make choices about how to best use your budget funds, how to develop your Spending Plan, creating an action plan to meet your goals, and so much more.
- Coordinate Services: They help you find services, activities, and staff that match your needs—even services outside the traditional system by using local businesess in your community.
- Ongoing Advocacy: The IF stands up for your rights, to ensure your voice is heard. They will make sure you are treated with dignity and respect.

## HOW DOES AN IF HELP WITH **SDP ENROLLMENT?**

Enrolling in SDP can be confusing, but an IF makes it easier:

- Orientation: They help you understand how SDP works and guide you through the steps.
- Paperwork and Meetings: They assist with forms, meetings, and making sure you meet the enrollment requirements.
- Creating Your PCP: The IF helps you develop a Person-Centered Plan (PCP) based on your goals and what supports you need.

The best part? Your IF gives you flexibility and control-they help you create a plan that is customized just for you and your unique needs

# Switching from traditional services to SDP takes planning.
