Proposed Services for 2023-2024

The Independent Facilitator Training Academy (IFTA), LLC., seeks to support the ALTA Self-Determination Local Advisory Committee's efforts in increasing the awareness of the Self-Determination Program in ALTA's catchment area.

OVERVIEW

We propose the creation of a 15-module Social Media Campaign video training series designed to educate self-advocates and their families about the benefits of the Self-Determination Program (SDP) as an alternative to the traditional system of services offered by Regional Centers. This proposal outlines the module curriculum, project costs, and benefits of this innovative approach.

OUR PROPOSAL

The video series will consist of 15 animated modules, each 3-5 minutes long, crafted to maintain attention and foster engagement. The content will be tailored to educate participants on various aspects of SDP, highlighting its advantages and process. The modules will be translated into Spanish, Hmong, and Russian, ensuring accessibility to a diverse audience.

Module Curriculum:

- Person-Centered Planning in SDP: Techniques for effective goal setting and how it can help participants achieve their life dreams.
- Budget Management in SDP: Understanding how your dreams and goals influence your individual budget.
- 5. **SDP for Early Start Consumers:** Understanding SDP for infants and toddlers.

- 6. **SDP for School-Aged Children:** Benefits in an educational and skill building with SDP.
- 7. **SDP for Young Adults:** Focus on independence and career planning.
- 8. **SDP for Adults:** Long-term planning and community living.
- 9. **Transitioning to SDP:** Steps and expectations in transitioning from traditional services.
- 10. Monitoring and Reviewing Progress: Tracking and adjusting plans in SDP.
- 11. **Rights and Advocacy within SDP:** Understanding how SDP enhances your legal rights and self-advocacy.
- 12. **Community Involvement through SDP**: Opportunities for community integration.
- 13. Family and Caregiver Roles in SDP: Their support in the SDP journey.
- 14. Overcoming Challenges in SDP: Identifying and addressing common issues.
- 15. **Future Planning and Growth:** Emphasizing the importance of ongoing development.

PROJECT DELIVERABLES

Following is a complete list of all project deliverables:

As part of this project, the following deliverables will be provided to the Self-Determination Committee of the ALTA Regional Center:

- 1. **Animated Video Series:** A set of 15 animated videos, each lasting between 3-5 minutes, covering the specified module topics. These videos will be crafted to be engaging and informative, suitable for self-advocates and their families.
- 2. **Translation Services:** Each video will be translated into Spanish, Hmong, and Russian, ensuring the series is accessible to a diverse audience. Translations will be precise and culturally sensitive.
- 3. **Transcripts and Subtitles:** Transcripts of each video in English and the three additional languages (Spanish, Hmong, Russian) will be provided. Subtitles will be integrated into the videos for accessibility.
- Accessibility Features: All videos and materials will be designed to be accessible, including features like closed captioning and descriptive audio where necessary.

The project timeline will commence upon funding approval and completion of contracts, with an estimated duration of 30-60 days or as agreed upon in the contract. IFTA and the

ALTA Regional Center Self-Determination Committee will meet to allow opportunities for input and feedback throughout the development process.
