

Request for Proposals (RFP)

Through the reporting of geographically defined resource development needs, identified through the Individual Program Plan development process, ACRC has established the following priorities in resource development during the remainder of the 2020 fiscal year:

Residential Services/Out of Home Respite to be available in the communities of Sacramento, Elk Grove, Roseville, Rocklin, El Dorado County and Grass Valley/Nevada City. Residential resources sought would include those capable of accommodating residents with needs in the areas of behavior intervention, incidental medical care, and varying levels of support with completion of activities of daily living, potentially up to and including total care. Environments would need to possess the ability to support both ambulatory and non-ambulatory individuals. Service models other than licensed Board and Care will be considered as a means of meeting the identified need.

Adult Day Services with a focus on socialization to be available for access in the communities of Sacramento, Elk Grove, Woodland, Roseville/Rocklin, Yuba City/Marysville, the Grass Valley/Nevada City area, and Placerville. Programs capable of accommodating non-ambulatory individuals who may also require total care and incidental medical care support would be preferred.

Adult Services: Behavior Management Programs to be available for access in the communities of Sacramento, Elk Grove, Woodland, Roseville/Rocklin, Yuba City/Marysville, the Grass Valley/Nevada City area, and Placerville.

Adult Services: Work based/Community Integration Training Programs to be available for access in the communities of Sacramento, Elk Grove, Roseville/Rocklin, Yuba City/Marysville.

Behavior Intervention Services to be available for access in the Sacramento, Placer, El Dorado, Nevada, Yuba, and Sutter County regions

Early Intervention Services to be available for access in the Sacramento, Yolo, El Dorado, Nevada, Colusa, Yuba, and Sutter County regions

Respite Agency: Incidental Medical Services to be available for access throughout the ACRC Catchment area.

In Home Respite Agency for access in Sacramento County (with a focus on the cities of Sacramento and Elk Grove) and Nevada County (with a focus on the communities of Grass Valley, Nevada City, and Truckee).

Psychologists for evaluation of service applicants throughout the ACRC catchment area
