


PURPOSE

HOW IT WORKS

The Blue Envelope Program provides individuals with the option to display the Blue Envelope logo or present a Blue Envelope when engaging with law enforcement or community service personnel. These Blue Envelope-branded items can contain essential documents, including personal identification, contact information, and important vehicle-related paperwork such as registration, proof of insurance and other relevant paperwork. There is no registry associated with the program, and participation is completely voluntary and self-implemented.
