NOTE. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, ACRC will not schedule any in-person meetings, orientations, or interviews for this Request for Proposal (RFP) process. Please read this notice carefully as our process has been modified.

Alta California Regional Center (ACRC), serving individuals with developmental disabilities, has identified a need to develop an Enhanced Behavioral Supports Home (EBSH) with a secured perimeter within ACRC's catchment area (Alpine, Colusa, El Dorado, Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, Sierra, Sutter, Yolo, and Yuba) for Adults who will be transitioning from a Porterville Developmental Center - Secure Treatment Program (PDC-STP) or individuals who are in jail and are being diverted from PDC.

Project 1: Adult Enhanced Behavioral Supports Home (EBSH) with delayed egress and secure perimeter (DE/SP) with HDO

Four (4) bed Enhanced Behavioral Supports Home (EBSH) with delayed egress and secure perimeter (DE/SP). This home will only serve clients who are transitioning from Porterville Developmental Center - Secure Treatment Program (PDC-STP) or individuals who are in jail and are being diverted from PDC. The home is expected to provide competency training which may be offered from a third-party competency trainer. This home is expected to serve clients with forensic involvement, substance abuse issues, etc. Clients may be on a court order commitment (i.e. 1370.1, 6500, 6509) or on diversion plans. This home will be designed to serve clients who are expected to have severe behaviors including, but not limited to, verbal and physical aggression, property destruction, resistive to daily routines, self-injurious behaviors, and AWOL.
